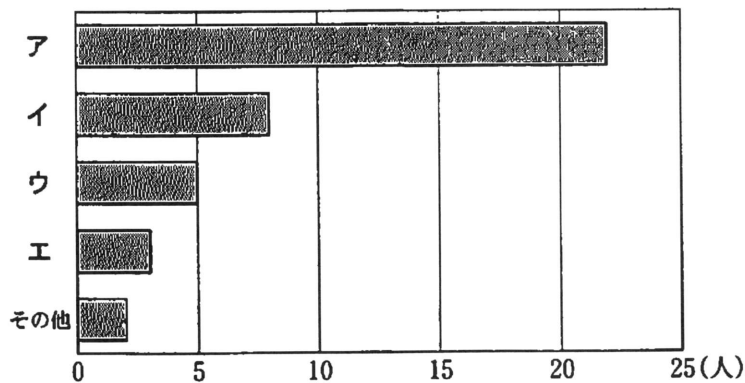

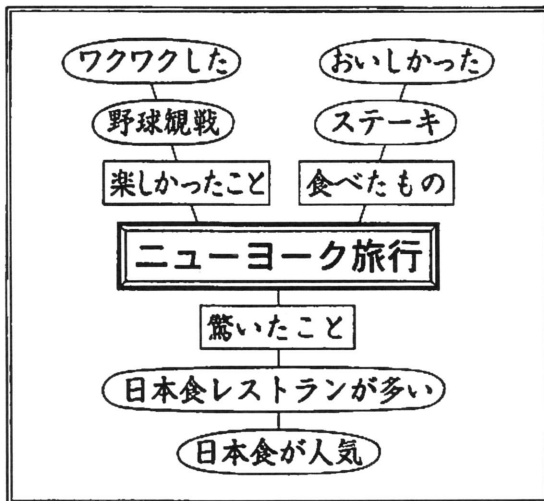

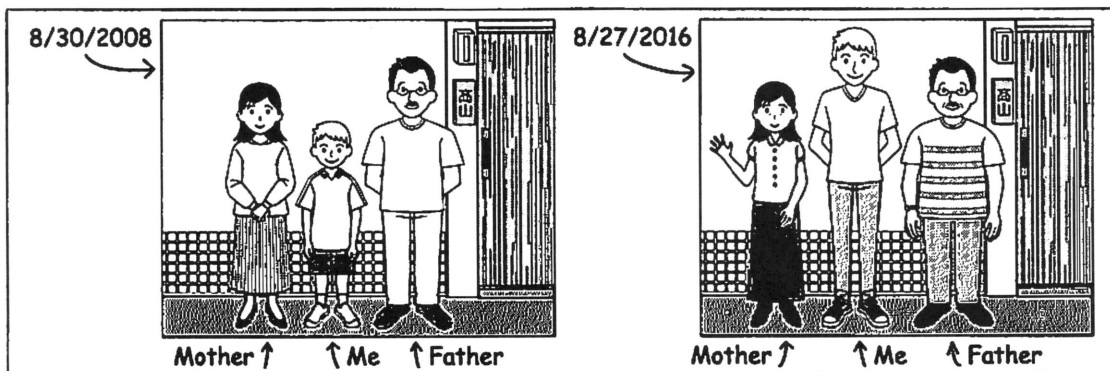

letters have you written in your life? Maybe some of you write a few letters in a year and send some e-mails every day. Before people started to use phones, letters were very useful for people.

Do you know the 18th century is called the \*age of letters in \*Europe? Today, we write letters to a \*particular person. At that time, however, people wrote not only \*private letters like this but also public letters. Public letters were read by the receivers and the people living around them. They wanted to get a lot of new information or news from those letters. The writers of the letters knew that too. . Some things in public letters were important, so writers sometimes \*copied the letters they wrote as \*records of the \*content.

\*Mozart also wrote a lot of letters. He traveled abroad a lot and his father sometimes traveled with him. Mozart got good ideas for his music. He traveled for about one third of his life and died when he was 35 years old. He sent many letters to his family while he was traveling. Most of them were written about himself and news or information about the places which he visited. His letters were long. He wanted the people living around his family to read his letters too. His father also wrote a lot of long letters while he was abroad.

Still now, we can see the letters written by Mozart and his father, so we can know about them well. We have records of their lives because they didn't talk on the phone. If you have important things to tell some people, why don't you write letters?
